Dear Parishioners...

With a certain sense of sadness, we said farewell to Pope Francis a week ago. His visit to our country and to our church by now seems like a dreamy, overwhelming, mesmerizing, experience that we will long remember. Almost miraculously, the Pope seemed to have the capacity to touch and inspire awe in just about everyone who was willing to open themselves to his presence, irrespective of religion, race or color.

Some ecclesiastical pundits, perhaps a little cynically, declare that the real measure of the success of his visit will be seen in whether Catholics who have wandered away from the Church, now return. Only time will tell that, but I can witness, after hearing confessions last Saturday, that his words and his presence was the catalyst for returning to Christ for more than one person around here already.

As I have disclosed at all the Masses for the past two weeks, I have been fairly preoccupied with the Diocesan Endowment Campaign for the past six months, but especially during the last two weekends which marked the formal end of the campaign. I am humbled at the openness and response of the parish to the appeal. Before I spoke at the Masses at St Margaret's last weekend, I heard Pope Francis at the Cathedral of St Peter and Paul in Philadelphia, talk about St Catherine Drexel, and he quoted one of his predecessors on the Throne of Peter, challenging the then wealthy Philadelphia socialite, to take responsibility for the Church and to do her part to make it vibrant and alive. *"Et Tu"* he asked her, *"What are you going to do? Every Christian man and woman by Baptism must respond to the call to build up the Body of Christ—the Church. What about you?"*. The question put the Appeal in a perspective, as we turn our attention to the future, and to the next generation that will sit in our pews after we have left them. Will we leave them an enriched, secure and vibrant church and parish?

While we do not have the final tally at the time of sending this bulletin to the printer, I feel confident to assert that we have attained our parish goal to raise \$1.825M in pledges for the campaign. If everyone who has made a verbal commitment follows through and returns their pledge card, we will be well on the way to the campaign formula that will see our parish as the recipient of 70% of funds raised above our goal. We will publish the accurate numbers in future bulletins.

If you have a pledge card and have not sent it in yet, please do so, or if you would like to sit and talk about the campaign, please call me, and I will be happy to discuss it with you.

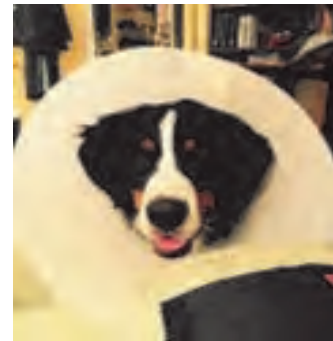

Children's Liturgy of the Word: All children, ages 4 and up are invited to attend the Children's Liturgy of the Word at the 10:00 AM Mass in St. Margaret's Church. There is no fee or registration required.

Marriages: Those planning marriage should notify the parish at least one year in advance. The Church sees marriage in one's own parish as the most proper arrangement, therefore, people who reside in St. Catharine - St. Margaret Parish have a right to be married here. Others should receive the sacrament in their own parishes. The bride, the groom, or their parents must be registered and living in this Parish for at least one year.
