

CHOOSING A CONFIRMATION NAME: REPORT

Write a report on the Saint you have chosen as your patron. The following questions should be used as a guide in writing your saint report. Please use paragraph form when writing the report.

1. What is your saint's name?
2. What point in history did your saint live?
3. What was life like at that point in history for your saint?
4. Where did your saint live?
5. What virtues do you see in your saint's example?
6. What difficulties and struggles did your saint encounter?
7. How did this saint follow Jesus in the way he or she lived?
8. How did this saint become holy?
9. What made you decide to choose this saint as your patron for Confirmation?
10. How did the saint die?
11. How is this saint an example for your life?
12. When was this saint canonized or beatified by the Catholic Church?
13. Include a prayer to your saint (find one on the internet or make up a prayer of your own)
14. Ask your parents about how and why they chose your baptismal name?

IMPORTANT: Make sure your final paper is your own work and not just copied from a website or book. Presenting another's work as your own is called plagiarism and is a form of stealing. Really think about your reasons for choosing this saint and begin asking them for guidance and the courage to help take your reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation seriously.
